Subject: Proclamation in Honor of Bisexual Pride Day

### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a proclamation that September 23, 2012 is Bisexual Pride Day in Berkeley.

## BACKGROUND

Officially known as Celebrate Bisexuality Day, Bisexual Pride Day is celebrated every year on September 23<sup>rd</sup> in recognition of the bisexual community and their supporters. Bisexual Pride day is a call for bisexual people, their friends and supporters to recognize and celebrate bisexuality history, bisexual community and culture, and the bisexual people in their lives.

The annual event first started back in 1999 by three bisexual rights activists and once took hold mainly in areas with a strong bisexual presence and is now celebrated worldwide. The bisexual community has grown in strength over time but in many ways is still invisible.

Bisexual pride is separate from the mainstream LGBT events and bisexuality has its own identity apart from being straight or gay. Bisexuals may be attracted to not one, but both genders. There are often negative and inaccurate connotations inaccurately associated with bisexual people. The goal is to increase awareness and understanding bisexuality as a sexuality of its own.

This celebration of bisexuality in particular, as distinct from general LGBT events, was conceived as a response to the prejudice and marginalization of the bisexual persons by some in both the straight and greater LGBT communities.

- **WHEREAS,** Bisexual Pride and Bi Visibility Day has been established by the bisexual community as an effort to further this goal of tolerance and awareness; and
- **WHEREAS**, the bisexual community is one integral to our City, with business owners and residents alike who are proud to be a part of the bisexual community, but hope for greater visibility; and
- WHEREAS, Berkeley has long demonstrated its support of the gay, lesbian, bi, and queer communities by such means as celebrating Pride Month, becoming the first city in the nation to establish a Domestic Partnership Registry, as well as LGBT Sensitivity Training for the Berkeley Police Department; and
- WHEREAS, while many advancements have been made with respect to equitable acceptance of bisexual people in our nation, the bisexual community remains a distinct one from the gay community and seeks acceptance as such, making it important for the City of Berkeley to demonstrate support for the community individually; and
- **WHEREAS,** the bisexual community has helped and continues to foster growth and acceptance in our City;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Berkeley hereby proclaims September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2012 to be
