Subject: Youth Spirit Artworks Request for Additional Funding to Get and Keep

Homeless Youth Off Berkeley Streets

## RECOMMENDATION

Consider Youth Spirit Artworks request for \$50,000 leveraging existing homeless youth services to get and keep homeless youth off Berkeley Streets through art jobs combined with referrals to services and shelter.

# **BACKGROUND**

Youth Spirit Artworks believes that a very creative and fiscally prudent solution to making a day-time space available for homeless youth in Berkeley--leveraging existing youth services available through YEAH Shelter and Youth Spirit Artworks--will be for Youth Spirit Artwork's homeless youth jobs training program and retail store to move this fall next to YEAH Shelter on University Avenue. A move in ready space next to YEAH is available now.

If the City: 1) leverages YSA's existing \$1,159 per month in rent; 2) leverages YSA's existing staffing capacity; 3) leverages YSA's existing youth job training stipends; and 4) leverage's YSA's existing job training resources with what YEAH offers--case management, groups, \$50K in current Prop. 63 funded yoga classes approved by the City, and winter shelter, with \$50K in additional funding for rent, staffing and youth stipends, Youth Spirit Artworks will be able to be open from 11am to 7pm Monday through Friday to serve additional youth who want to come to our program from Telegraph and Shattuck Avenue--but who right now won't come because of the distance to the current space in South Berkeley. All of these youth will have the opportunity to take advantage of what YEAH currently is able to provide.

- 2) RENT 2 X LARGER SPACE TO ACCOMMODATE ON SITE CASE MANAGEMENT & MORE YOUTH INDOORS
- 3) INCREASE DAYTIME HRS FALL/WINTER/SPRING 11:30AM TO 7:30PM
- 4) INCREASE SR. ARTIST HRS TO SUPPORT 1 FT STAFF POSITION
- 5) INCREASE NUMBER OF YOUTH ABLE TO BE SERVED DAILY RECEIVING TRAINING STIPENDS +8
