SUBJECT: Naming Berkeley's Public Health Clinic for Ann Chandler

RECOMMENDATION:

Refer the attached request to the Public Works Commission to name the Public Health Clinic at University/San Pablo for former Councilmember Ann Chandler and convey Council's support.

BACKGROUND:

Ann Chandler served on the Berkeley City Council from 1984 to 1992. She was a staunch public health advocate, championed the established of the Health Center at Berkeley High School and fought patient dumping at our local hospitals, and actively pursued research on HIV. On her first night on the Council Ann Chandler introduced the recommendation to establish domestic partner benefits for City employees. A more full description of her achievements is attached along with over 100 signatures requesting the naming.

The Public Works Commission is the appropriate commission according to the naming procedures Council adopted.

We write to ask the Berkeley City Council to honor the late Ann Chandler, a longtime resident of the City of Berkeley, a former member of the City Council, and a dedicated and inspirational health care advocate, by naming the West Berkeley Family Practice at 2031 6th Street in Ms. Chandler's honor.

During Ann Chandler's 43 years in Berkeley, public health in all its aspects, and the health of the Berkeley community in particular, was her passion, the focus of her professional life, and her legacy as a public servant.

Ms. Chandler had a bachelor's degree in biology from the University of New Hampshire and a master's of science in public health from Cal State Hayward. From 1981 until 2006, she was director of the Alameda County Public Health Laboratory. During her retirement, she worked for the California Department of Public Health as an examiner for the Facility Licensing Division.

Ms. Chandler was a member of numerous civic and health-oriented organizations in the Bay Area including the Berkeley Library Board of Directors and the board of Community Conservation Centers, but we take particular pride in her service to the City of Berkeley and her public health accomplishments here in our community. She was an elected member of the Berkeley City Council from 1984 to 1992 and the Council's leading public health advocate. On her first night in office she introduced the City of Berkeley's ordinance that established domestic partner benefits for City of Berkeley employees, the first city in the nation to do so. Among her other health advocacy successes Ms. Chandler led the effort to establish the health center at Berkeley High, fought patient dumping at our local hospitals and actively championed for research on HIV and non-discrimination toward and support of those living with AIDS.

We, the undersigned, support a resolution to honor and recognize her legacy of public health accomplishments by naming the West Berkeley Family Practice at 2031 6th Street in her honor.
