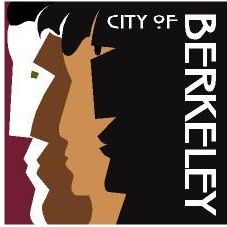

INTRODUCTION

This report corrects information on the tally of the Landmarks Preservation Commission vote to designate the building located at 2517 Regent Street as a Landmark, Structure of Merit. See Item 29 of the May 21, 2013 Council Agenda.

CURRENT SITUATION AND ITS EFFECTS

The Council Report for Item 29 of the May 21, 2013 Council agenda incorrectly represents the tally of the Landmarks Preservation Commission vote approving the designation of 2517 Regent Street as a Landmark, Structure of Merit. This correction clarifying the tally does not affect the outcome of the decision to designate the property.

Correction in LPC vote tally: Staff incorrectly stated that on November 1, 2012 the Landmarks Preservation Commission (LPC) approved the Landmark, Structure of Merit designation for the building by a 5-3-0-1 vote. On September 6, 2012 the LPC did initiate consideration of the designation by a 5-3-0-1 vote (Linville, Ng, Ruegg, opposed; Wagley, absent). However, on November 1, 2012 the LPC approved the Landmark, Structure of Merit designation for the building by a 5-2-1-0 vote (Linville, Ruegg opposed; Hall abstained). One member had obtained an excused absence for the meeting.
