Subject: "A Night in Berkeleywood": Relinquishment of Council Office Budget Funds to General Fund and Grant of Such Funds

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution approving the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$1,200 per Councilmember including \$1,200 from Mayor Bates to the Berkeley Film Foundation, the fiscal sponsor of "A Night in Berkeleywood", a fundraising event for the Berkeley Film Foundation, with funds relinquished to the City's general fund for this purpose from the discretionary Council Office Budgets of Mayor Bates and any other Councilmembers who would like to contribute.

FISCAL IMPACTS OF RECOMMENDATION

No General Fund impact; \$1,200 is available from Mayor Bates' Council Office Budget discretionary account.

BACKGROUND

The Berkeley FILM Foundation is a 501(c)(3) grant program for independent filmmakers annually funded by the City of Berkeley, Wareham Development and the Saul Zaentz Company with a mission to nurture, sustain and preserve the thriving Berkeley film community while attracting the next generation of filmmakers. The BFF focuses on supporting the ideals reflected in the Berkeley culture: social, historical and innovative documentary and dramatic works.

'A Night in Berkeleywood' is a collaborative effort and event organized by The Downtown Berkeley Association, The Hotel Shattuck Plaza, The Berkeley FILM Foundation, Visit Berkeley, The Berkeley Chamber of Commerce, and Gemini Marketing & Promotions benefiting the Berkeley FILM Foundation.

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF SURPLUS FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE EXPENSE ACCOUNTS OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS FOR A GRANT TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SERVICES FOR A MUNICIPAL PUBLIC PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Mayor Tom Bates has surplus funds in his office expenditure account (budget code 010-01-01-410); and

WHEREAS, a California non-profit tax exempt corporation Berkeley FILM Foundation seeks funds in the amount of \$1,200 to provide the following public services to support the mission of the Berkeley FILM Foundation which is to support the ideals reflected in the Berkeley culture: social, historical and innovative documentary and dramatic works; and

WHEREAS, the provision of such services would fulfill the following municipal public purpose of provide grants to Berkeley-based filmmakers (live and/or work) and who are in the production, post-production, and distributions stages of feature-length or short-form narratives or documentaries.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that funds relinquished by the Mayor and Councilmembers from their Council Office Budget up to \$1,200 per office shall be granted to Berkeley FILM Foundation to fund the following services: providing grants to Berkeley-based filmmakers (live and/or work) and who are in the production, post-production, and distributions stages of feature-length or short-form narratives or documentaries.
