INTRODUCTION

The City Council made a referral on April 16, 2002 regarding possibly extending the advance notice for construction tow-away zones to 72 hours.

CURRENT SITUATION AND ITS EFFECTS

The current minimum time limit for posting No Parking signs is 24 hours. This may not be sufficient for all members of the public who are affected.

BACKGROUND

On June 6, 2002, the Public Works Commission passed a motion (MSC Campbell/St. John – Alward, Broderick absent) that the Commission supports the concept of extending the advance notice to 72 hours.

The Council made a referral on April 16, 2002 on possibly extending the advance notice for construction tow-away from the current 24 hours to 72 hours.
