Subject: Proclamation: United Nations Day, October 24

At the regular meeting of October 20, 2003, the Peace and Justice Commission unanimously (Absent: Arasteh, Brody, Cohen, Wright) approved a motion endorsing Mayor Bates' proclamation on behalf of the United Nations.

In voting to endorse the Mayor's proclamation proclaiming October 24, 2003 as United Nations Day in the City of Berkeley, the Peace and Justice Commission wishes to emphasize the importance of multi-lateral actions and cooperation in dealing with the world's problems, and that the United Nations in fact plays an important role in the world today. We also re-affirm the basic tenant of the United Nations and the American system – that is the rule of law.
