**Subject:** **Amend the City's MOU with AC Transit to Include Off-peak Parking on the Northwest Corner of Monterey Avenue and Hopkins Street**

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Request that the City Manager amend the MOU with the Alameda-Contra Costa Transportation District (AC Transit) to allow parking in the bus zone on the northwest corner of Monterey Avenue and Hopkins street except during weekday morning peak commute periods

BACKGROUND:

On November 12, 2002, the Council approved a recommendation to the City Manager to negotiate an MOU with AC Transit for parking in one of the bus zones on Monterey Avenue and Hopkins Street during off-peak periods for a trial period of six months. The MOU has been in place, and the bus stop on the northeast corner of Monterey and Hopkins has been used for parking in off-peak periods for a period of about two months, with no problems reported.

This request will allow an extension of the MOU to include parking in the bus zones on both sides of the street during periods when they are not required for use as bus stops. Only trans-bay buses use these bus stops. They are required only during weekday morning or afternoon commute periods. The six-month trial period will include the bus/parking arrangement on both sides of Monterey Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Staff time to consult with AC Transit and to implement signage and monitor the bus/parking areas.
