Subject: Approval of Neighborhood Traffic Calming Projects

RECOMMENDATION

That Council approve the recommendations contained in the City Manager's report on Neighborhood Traffic Calming Projects with the addition of the Addison and McKinley traffic calming treatments listed in Councilmember Spring's report.

FISCAL IMPACTS OF RECOMMENDATION

Approval of the projects and the associated budgets simultaneously has the best chance of resulting in a reduction in per unit cost of these installations.

BACKGROUND

At its regular meeting of July 15, 2004, the Transportation Commission passed the following motion: It was MSC (Alfsen/Landau) that Council adopt the City Manager's recommendations on Neighborhood Traffic Calming Projects in full, with the addition of the Addison and McKinley traffic calming treatments in Dona Spring's proposal, and that all of this traffic calming funding be fully approved. 
RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION
