Our neighborhood association voted to support Ward Street Neighbors in regard to the arbitrary installation of eighteen cell phone antennas atop 2721 Shattuck Avenue. Nearby residents in three directions will be directly effected.

The distinctions between how the Gilman Street Neighbors were supported while the Ward/Shattuck project (Ten times larger!) was approved are remarkable. Just because the location address was listed as Shattuck Avenue does not mean that the hundreds of homes close by can be completely ignored.

Of particular concern is the irrational acceptance by ZAB of evidence of "need" provided by the companies themselves. This an open invitation to allow unlimited installation of such antennas everywhere the companies say that there is a "need".

The LeConte Neighborhood Association requests that the City Council overturn the ZAB approval for the eighteen cell phone antennas planned for 2721 Shattuck Avenue.
