Subject: Holocaust Remembrance Day Proclamation

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Berkeley City Council adopts the Holocaust Remembrance Day proclamation.

BACKGROUND:

On April 15th at 1pm, at 2134 Martin Luther King Jr. Way, at the City Council chambers, we will be honoring a Berkeley Holocaust survivor, along with other Holocaust survivors from the Bay Area on International Holocaust Remembrance Day.

The fifth annual Holocaust Remembrance Day event will host a variety of guests, including children and grandchildren of Holocaust survivors, cultural performers, poets, and community members. The event is being planned by a variety of community members, the City of Berkeley, and a representative of Jewish Family & Children's Services (JFCS), East Bay. JFCS is the only organization in the Bay Area that hosts Café Europa, a social and cultural program that allows survivors and their families stay in touch with each other than the resources they need.
