RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an amendment to Contract No. 7349 with Fugro West, Inc., for environmental monitoring services by \$27,780 for an amount not to exceed \$62,035 through June 30, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACTS OF RECOMMENDATION

Sufficient funding for this contract amendment is allocated in FY 2008 in budget code 010-5850-450-30.35-04PK69. The CMS number is C2626.

CURRENT SITUATION AND ITS EFFECTS

During the mass grading portion of the Gilman project in June and July of 2007, the soils at the site compacted to a greater extent than was anticipated due to soil moisture content, and resulted in a need for an additional 6,800 cubic yards of clean fill. The City needed Fugro West to provide environmental monitoring services regarding several sources of potential fill in order to obtain suitable fill for the project, which was completed by mid-September, 2007. Staff recommends approval of a contract amendment to cover this additional scope of services.

BACKGROUND

On May 8, 2007, the Berkeley City Council approved a construction contract for the Gilman Street Sports Fields project with McGuire and Hester, Inc., of Oakland, CA in the amount of \$5,003,075. On May 22, 2007, the City authorized a contract with Fugro West, Inc. for environmental monitoring services during excavation at the Gilman Street Sports Fields Project in the amount of \$34,255 (Council Resolution No. 63,702-N.S.)

RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION

In order to obtain additional suitable fill for the Gilman project in a timely manner, the City needed Fugro to provide additional environmental monitoring services.

CONTRACT NO. 7349 AMENDMENT: ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING SERVICES
