

RESOLUTION NO. 62,191-N.S.

AUTHORIZING THE REALLOCATION OF FY2002 EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG) FUNDS FROM BUILDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR SELF-SUFFICIENCY, INC. (BOSS) TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$58,974 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS (UST) AT THE 711 HARRISON STREET SHELTER

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City remove the UST at the 711 Harrison Street Shelter as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2003 the Housing Advisory Commission unanimously recommended the reallocation of \$58,974 from BOSS, Inc. to the City's Public Works Department to allow full funding for the UST removal; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2003 the Council authorized the City Manager to execute a contract with Golden Gate Tank Removal, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Berkeley authorizes the reallocation of FY2002 Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funds from Building Opportunities for Self-Sufficiency, Inc. to the City of Berkeley Public Works Department in the amount of \$58,974 for the purpose of providing funding for the removal of UST at the 711 Harrison Street Shelter.


The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Berkeley City Council on September 9, 2003 by the following vote:


