

RESOLUTION NO. 62,194-N.S.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACTION TO PROVIDE A \$5,000 CASH REWARD TO THOSE WHO PROVIDE INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HIT-RUN INJURY COLLISION INVOLVING OFFICER BEN CARDOZA ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 20, 2003

WHEREAS, the City of Berkeley has a commitment to public safety; and

WHEREAS, Officer Ben Cardoza was seriously injured by a hit-run driver; and

WHEREAS, closure of this crime will bring relief to public safety employees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Berkeley authorizes the City Manager to provide a \$5,000 cash reward to those who provide information leading to the arrest and conviction of those criminally responsible for injuring Officer Ben Cardoza. Funding for this expenditure is in the FY2004 budget of the Office of the City Manager.
