

RESOLUTION NO. 62,195-N.S.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY AMENDMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000 FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS WITH PACIFIC BELL (PACBELL) TO RELOCATE THE UTILITY LINES FOR THE SEVENTH STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the widening of Seventh Street requires relocation of the utilities of PacBell between Potter Street and Anthony Street; and

WHEREAS, the City does not have the resources to undertake this type complex undergrounding work; and

WHEREAS, the City requires the utility company to provide services for relocation of their utilities, and the contracts have been entered in the Citywide contract database with CMS #VA6MY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Berkeley authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract and any amendments until completion of the project with PacBell for the Seventh Street Improvements Project in an amount not to exceed \$90,000 (Budget Code: 675-5302-432.30-38-03TP31/03TP32/03TP33, Wareham Contribution Fund). A record signature copy of the said agreement and any amendments to be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Berkeley City Council on September 9, 2003 by the following vote:
