

RESOLUTION NO. 62,199-N.S.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO 1) ACCEPT THE TFCA GRANT OF \$50,000, AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS WITH THE ALAMEDA COUNTY CONGESTION MANAGEMENT AGENCY (ALAMEDA COUNTY CMA); AND 2) APPROPRIATE THE GRANT FUNDING FOR RELATED EXPENSES FOR BERKELEY TRIP OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Transportation for Clean Air Funds toward Berkeley TRiP will assist with the City's monetary contribution for FY2002-2003; and

WHEREAS, the City will be able to save \$50,000, and explore other alternatives for the future, since Berkeley TRiP has closed its doors; and

WHEREAS, the City made a commitment to secure supplemental funding for Berkeley TRiP, which was a regional model for promoting commute alternatives through transit ticket sales and information.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any amendments with the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency and accept the grant in order to supplement the City's contribution for Berkeley TRiP operations by \$50,000 to be deposited into budget code 010-0902-431-3038, for 2002/2003. A record signature copy of said agreement and any amendments to be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Berkeley City Council on September 9, 2003 by the following vote:


