

RESOLUTION NO. 62,743–N.S.

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 58,819–N.S. AND ESTABLISHING A ROTATION SCHEDULE FOR THE OFFICE OF VICE-MAYOR

WHEREAS, prior to 1997, pursuant to Resolution 53,583–NS, the policy of the Council was to have each member of the Council serve as Vice Mayor for a period of three months in every two-year term of office; and

WHEREAS, the Council now serves four-year staggered terms as a result of Measure L passed by voters in November 1994; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, Council rescinded Resolution No. 53,583–N.S. and adopted Resolution No. 58,819–NS appointing Councilmember Maudelle Shirek as Vice Mayor of the City of Berkeley.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that the Office of the Vice Mayor return to a rotation schedule where each member of the Council will serve as Vice Mayor for three months every two years according to the following schedule:

December 2005 – February 2005	Wozniak, District 8	2 years
March – May 2006	Moore, District 2	0 years
June – August 2006	Anderson, District 3	0 years
September – November 2006	Capitelli, District 5	0 years


