

RESOLUTION NO. 63,762-N.S.

CONTRACT WITH THE DOWNTOWN BERKELEY YMCA FOR LOW COST FITNESS CENTER MEMBERSHIPS FOR CITY EMPLOYEES FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2007 TO JUNE 30, 2008

WHEREAS, the City has had an agreement with the Downtown Berkeley YMCA to provide low cost fitness memberships for City employees and legislative assistants; and

WHEREAS, the City's labor contracts require the City to pay 75 percent of the total membership cost; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement began on July 1, 2006 and ends on June 30, 2007 and a new contract is proposed for FY 20078; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the current year budget in the budget code 930-9701-410-2090 and the contract has been entered into the City contract database, and assigned CMS No. DKH8X.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract and any amendments with the Downtown Berkeley YMCA for low cost fitness center memberships for City of Berkeley employees and legislative assistants for the period July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 in the amount not to exceed \$254,448. A record signature copy of said contract and any amendments to be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Berkeley City Council on July 10, 2007 by the following vote:


