

RESOLUTION NO. 63,765-N.S.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGIES INC. INCREASING
THE AMOUNT BY \$13,625 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$113,625

WHEREAS, it is vital for public safety that the current City of Berkeley Police computer system is replaced by a state of the art system; and

WHEREAS, Innovative Technologies Inc. has in-depth experience in the acquisition and implementation of police systems in many California jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, contract negotiations with New World Systems Inc., in which Innovative Technologies played an important role, took significantly longer than expected; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in FY 2007 budget code 010-6901-420-3038.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Berkeley authorizes the City Manager to amend the agreement with Innovative Technologies Inc. increasing the amount by \$13,625 for a total not to exceed \$113,625 (CMS No. IKWD5).
