- f. Maudelle Shirek Commemorative Mural –Mildred Howard and Daniel Galvez were selected as the finalists at the June 1, 2006 Public Art Selection Panel meeting. Maudelle Shirek will be invited to the next Public Art Committee meeting where the artists will present a final model of the project.
