## *\$30,000 in Reward Money*

**Berkeley, California (Monday, February 27, 2006)** – Berkeley's City Manager Phil Kamlarz approved two \$15,000 rewards be offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the city's two recent homicides.

The first homicide occurred on February 10, 2006 on the 700 Block of Contra Costa Ave. **Juan Ramos, 18** of El Cerrito was stabbed to death, while attending a party.

The second homicide occurred on February 19, 2006 on the 1200 Block of Carrison St. where 24-year old **Keith Stephens** of Berkeley was shot to death.

Both of the cases are open and active, but to date, no credible tips have been called into the Homicide Unit. The rewards are consistent with established City of Berkeley Policy.
