Help the Police catch us!

We want to get caught



Berkeley, California (Thursday, September 28, 2006) – Berkeley Police Robbery Investigators are asking for help in identifying these two individuals. On September 22, 2006, five black male suspects carjacked two male victims here in Berkeley on the 3000 block of Shattuck Ave.

This incident occurred at about 1:40 A.M. During the robbery, two male victims were pulled out of the car and thrown on the ground where the suspects threatened to shoot the victims. The group of five suspects then drove off in the victim's 2006 silver Acura TL.

On September 24, 2006, Oakland Police responded to a pedestrian robbery, where a group of black males were described as being responsible. OPD recovered the 2006 silver Acura and took one of the five suspects into custody during this incident. During the search of the recovered car, the victim from Berkeley noticed that ***the two above suspects took pictures of themselves with the victim's camera.***

Investigators, say that this group is responsible for several other robberies in Berkeley, Oakland and Piedmont.
