RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution confirming the results of the June 8, 2010 Special Municipal Election for Measure C – The Berkeley Public Pools Bond.

CURRENT SITUATION AND ITS EFFECTS

The Alameda County Registrar of Voters has submitted to the City Clerk the official Statement of Votes cast for the City of Berkeley Special Municipal Election held on June 8, 2010 and the City Clerk has prepared the enclosed Certification of Election Results.

The enclosed Resolution confirms the results of the June 8, 2010 Election and declares that Measure C did not obtain the required two-thirds vote threshold for passage.

BACKGROUND

The City conducted a Special Municipal Election on June 8, 2010. One measure was placed on the ballot by the Council.

CONFIRMING THE CANVASS OF RETURNS, INCLUDING VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS,
OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD JUNE 8, 2010, AND DECLARING
THE RESULTS

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election consolidated with the primary for the California Governor's election was held in the City of Berkeley on June 8, 2010; and

WHEREAS, at said election the qualified electors, including vote by mail voters, cast ballots upon the following proposed Measure:

Measure C
Berkeley Public Pools Bond
(2/3 vote required)

Shall City of Berkeley Community Facilities District No. 2: incur bonded indebtedness not exceeding \$22,500,000 to replace the multiuse indoor Warm Pool, renovate Willard and West Campus pools, construct a multipurpose pool at King; levy a special tax at a rate not exceeding \$0.0258 per square foot of building area to finance that indebtedness and not exceeding \$0.0126, indexed for inflation, to maintain pools and operate aquatics programs; and establish an annual District appropriations limit of \$3,500,000?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total number of votes, including vote by mail votes, cast on ballot measures was as follows:

MEASURE C – Public Pools Bond	YES	16,341
(2/3 vote required)	NO	9,912

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above measure did not obtain the required two-thirds vote threshold for passage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total number of ballots cast in the City of Berkeley at said election was 26,253. Attached hereto is the Certification of the City Clerk (Exhibit A) including the Certificate of the Election by the Registrar of Voters and a complete Statement of the Results showing the number of votes cast at each precinct for and against Measure C.
