# COMMON SENSE FOR BICYCLISTS

Every person riding a bicycle is subject to the same rules of the road as the driver of a vehicle, including but not limited to, provisions concerning driving under the influence of alcoholic beverages or drugs. VC 21200 (a)

- ✓ **Always ride with traffic.**
- ✓ **Bicycles do not have the right-of-way in crosswalks unless you are walking.**
- ✓ **If there is a bicycle lane, use it.**
- ✓ **Wear a bicycle helmet.**
- ✓ **Signal your turns and moves.**
