The City of Berkeley Aquatics / Swim Program offer three swim centers in different areas of the city. The City of Berkeley Aquatics program includes a youth swim team, adult masters team, diving lessons, adult swim lessons, aquatic leisure classes (spirit walking), arthritis exercise lifeguard training, junior lifeguard program, parent and tot classes, family swimming, Tiny Tot Time, year round public swim and water safety instruction. We host specialized programs including: "Conquer your Fear," and other swim programs for the special needs populations.

### THE POSITION:

This position is responsible for:

- Teaching all swim levels
- Certify swimming participant's completion of swim curriculum level
- Rescue swimmers in danger of drowning and administer first aid as needed
- Maintain a clean and orderly pool area to ensure the safety of all members
- Performs related work as assigned

### QUALIFICATIONS:

To qualify for this position, you must be at least 16 years of age. A minimum of two summer seasons working as a lifeguard or swim instructor.

Must possess a valid Water Safety Instructor certificate (WSI), which requires an American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certificate and successful completion of first aid and CPR for the professional rescuers is required.

**TB and fingerprint clearance required for employment. Candidates under 18 must provide a work permit.**

### APPLICATION PROCESS:

To apply for this opening, you must complete an employment application and attach a copy of your WSI, Lifeguard and CPR certificate by **Friday, March 12, 2009**. *Your application will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted if you do not attach your certificates.*

Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications will be invited to participate in the Swim Test. Subsequently, successful candidates will then be invited to participate in the oral interview process. Below are the tentative dates for the swim test and oral interview.
